

ORDINANCE NO. 1609

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1397

WHEREAS, the City Council of La Junta, (hereinafter referred to as the "Council"); and

WHEREAS, the City has previously created a City of La Junta Historic Preservation Advisory Board by enacting Ordinance 1397; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to make administrative changes to said Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA JUNTA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 2.38.020 is repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2: A new Section 2.38.020 is enacted as follows:

2.38.020 - Board established.

The Historic Preservation Advisory Board is hereby created to be known as the City's Historic Preservation Advisory Board (the "Board"), which shall have principal responsibilities for matters of historic preservation as set forth in Sections 2.38.040 through 2.38.100 herein.


- A. Membership: The Board shall consist of a minimum of the duly appointed and then serving members of the City of La Junta Urban Renewal Authority.
- B. All members of the Board shall serve without compensation except for such amounts determined appropriate by the City Council to offset

expenses incurred by Board members in the performance of their duties as Board members.
